**SCCYSC Meeting Update:** Lisa Seeger attended the league meeting. Meeting was called early due to infantile behavior. No report given by Lisa. Mid County may express the club's resentment at the next league meeting.

Bob reported that D3 coach Juan Concepcion was in a serious car accident. Bob will send a card from the MC Board.

Kelly discussed the issue of poaching vs. recruiting players from other clubs and/or levels. It will be on the agenda for the next league meeting and definitions will be discussed.

Scotts Valley has decided to stay with CYSA and not move to US Soccer for both rec and D3.

**Treasurer Report's:** Val had nothing financial to add. A decision was made for those families who didn't pay for their children to play last year need to pay in cash or money order to register for the Fall season.

**Secretary Report:** No Report

**Registrar Report:** Registration for Fall has begun. D3 folders will be put together with the same paperwork as last year. However, players who registered within CYSA last year will not have to fill out a reg form to try-out.

**Division 3 Coordinator:** Kelly Binger gave report:

- D3 coaches have been approved.
- Dave Morello's U17G "Waves" want to move to either D1 or up to U18 due to the fact they won the A division last year. We already have a U18G team (Sparks). Kelly will see if D1 is an option for them.
- Kelly will see if we need to approve D3 Asst coaches-Bob and Linda thought we did.
- Kelly wants all players emailed about try-outs on the 19<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. Linda said she would.
- The deadline to accept players for a D3 team is May 4.

**Field Report:** Ray and Martha reported:

- Do we want Jade Street and AJC on Fridays? Jade St gets little use-Bob suggested fields 1 & 2 at AJC

- Given a choice between Shoreline and Del Mar for games, Del Mar was favored. The fact that there aren't netted goals may be an issue. There was discussion about the possibility of MC donating goals but no decision was made.
- Games will be at: Soquel High, AJC, Jade Street, and Del Mar.

**Ref Report:**

- Arbiter has moved to the county site.
- Refs will be ranked. Priority will be given to adults and the higher ranked refs.
- Bob is still planning to schedule a ref class. He's thinking it will be June 23, 25, 27, 28. Priority will be given to adults.
- The ref class info will be included in the try-out email Linda will be sending out.

- Jim talked to Kris Kirby about printing Mid County's rec uniforms this year. They would be all vinyl, \$1.50 for sponsor name, and \$1.00 for the MC logo. He will find out about screen costs.
- Banners are up at Live Oak and Green Acres. Jim will hang 3<sup>rd</sup> banner at Shoreline and ask Ted Donnelly to put 4<sup>th</sup> banner at corner of Soquel and Bay/Porter.
- A motion was made and approved to order a D3 tryout banner to post at each tryout; up to \$75.
- Kelly will let Shawn know that there are coaches interested in getting their D license.
- Liability Insurance-we as a board are not covered under our current policy. Robert Rhoades stated to Bob that for a \$1 million policy, the cost is \$400/year. A motion was made and accepted to increase our coverage. Bob will research further. Kelly will email the other clubs to see if they have liability insurance
- We need age group coordinators. Mike Fong agreed to do U12, U14 and U16 boys. Linda will email parents about the need for help.
- Bob is looking into scheduling another rec coaching clinic. Bill from SC and Hillel may do one.
- Earthquakes are offering group nights again this year. Also the women's soccer league in Santa Clara have group rates. Bob will find out the specific dates.
