Treasurer Report's: Val says we have about 52,000 in checkbook, but we still need to pay bills.

Secretary Report: Best Western is booked for coaches meeting, Board needs to be there at 500. Food is ordered we are anticipating about 60 people including the board. Board will bring desserts and coolers. When we have the schedules completed we can get to Shooting Stars and they will schedule picture day.

Registrar Report: Linda reported all the binders are basically done, except for two. Lots of registrations. Ads and drops can start to take place now. Are registration is about the same as last year. Some parents didn't pay the rate amount, most over paid, Linda has contacted these parents several times and we have not had a response. Overpayments will be assumed as donations.

Division 3 Coordinator: Kelly Binger gave report:

Coaches Coordinator: D license clinic may not happen, not enough interest. **Bob also reported that David Downey is the U6 boy's coordinator.**

Old Business:

Coach's dinner/Meeting: Set for July 29th at the Best Western. Board needs to be there at 500. Food is ordered we are anticipating about 60 people including the board. Board will bring desserts and coolers. The room will be set up the same and we will give tickets to people when they arrive. Jim will give out some balls and possibly coaches T-shirts if there are enough. Jim will order the uniforms and we will need to order about 70 shirts for coaches. Age Group updates: The best estimate for teams is:

U6 girls: 4 teams
U6 boys: 10 teams
U8 girls: 6 teams
U8 boys: 10 teams
U10 girls: 3 teams
U10 boys: 6 teams

U12 girls: 2 teams
U12 boys: 3 teams
U14 girls: 1 team
U 14 boys: 1 team

U 16 & U18 boys and girls do not have enough players to field teams, soccer clubs are looking at playing a U18 coed.

When we have a definite number of teams we will start assigning fields and times.

New Business:

Sponsor update: Marilyn reported that we have 18 total sponsors at this time and she is hoping to get at least 10 more. We have about 46 rec. teams.

Training for rec. coaches: Bob reported that the training for rec. coaches is scheduled for Aug. 7th, tentative time and place is Anna Jean, from 6-8. Hillel will then do follow up with the rec. coaches at their practices. The training is optional for U6.

August 29th Jamboree: It was decided that the official start of rec. soccer will be on Aug. 29th with a Jamboree style carnival at Anna Jean. We will give out uniforms and have shortened matches for all teams. Emphasis on fun! This date will be included with their schedules as the first day of play.

Field Lining: A motion was made and passed unanimously to have Jim and his painting crew paint the lines at the beginning of the season for \$100.00 per field. There are approximately 7 fields at a cost of not more than \$700.00.
