President's Report: Kelly reported about league meeting started to approve minute's lots of errors Aptos tried to video tape president threatened to call police meeting ended and canceled. A meeting will happen this week and we are not included as well as Aptos, Pajaro meeting with cysaa. Sebastian said the meetings can't be recorded. The meetings are public and need to be in a public place. We have drafted a letter and will submit in July. Mid county amount of the 25,000 is about 28%. There will be a new election in November. We will send a letter to freeze the funds before October.

Referee classes and August 14th scrimmages/referee on field training: June 22nd slowly filling up, lots of 13 year olds, would like more adults. Bob will put a letter together to give to them after they pass so they know how to sign up. Bob wanted to have a scrimmage for the on field training for the ref's, great idea for the new coaches; they could make a 10.00 fee for their effort. Also would be good for ref's who didn't ref. a lot last year. Ray had question about ref renewal, you are not notified, it is done annually the issue is with US soccer not notifying people. Bob thinks each of the teams need to share in the cost of the scrimmages. A motion was not made. The cost would be about 35.00 per field for the day and the cost of the ref's. Bob will do a budget.

New Business:

Board member contact data sheet: Mike would like to do a spreadsheet to get contact information for the board. Mike will set it up and only share it with board members.

D3 teams with players playing up: Kelly says panthers have 6 girls playing up and strikers have 4 playing up, u10 boys and u11 girls each have one. Bob made a motion to approve Max Walters Mackenzie Rastatter to play up motion approved, approve also the panthers and strikers players approved. Kelly also mentioned that rec players have been pulled up to play in D3 you could do a guest player. Now this won't work because we are doing it in house, the players would have to be on the D3 roster but still play rec, would need to it would be ok to pay one registration fee, coaches decision the coaches would need to work together. The registration will be in house.

U9 NorCal: Kelly both u9 teams are registered in NORCAL, the only thing is they can't play in CYSA district cup, the only disadvantage is the time commitment, 3 weekends versus one weekend.

AJC Field Configuration: Bob has questions regarding the configuration of AJC, especially the u10 teams, field 4 an u10 size field and bob sent Mary at the county an email, league isn't using that field, move u8 to field 1, field 3 u 10 mornings in the afternoon u12 field 1 later. Bob diagramed it out and we will try this configuration and get approval from the county. We don't see any disadvantage to this. We could get field 4 on Sundays wait until softball is over, which is the first of August. We would need to get goals for the u10 fields. Breakers approached bob and offered to line the fields they would also be willing to buy the goals and leave them there, we would like field 4 for Sundays. We need to rent that field now. We need the field available the 1st of September, bob will send Martha the dates, and we have the fields on Fridays for sure after august 1st. We would prefer to buy our own goals
